I ask that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers take immediate action and work with officials in Mount Pleasant and Racine County, as well as the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, to address the situation before land erodes any further.

Because regulatory and project authorizations are handled separately by each of these district offices, I ask that action be effectively coordinated by the Corps to best serve my constituents and protect public utilities.
