Dear Administrator Gaynor,

I am writing to request an expedited processing of resource requests for additional lab testing supplies and personal protective equipment (PPE) for first responders and health care workers.

I greatly appreciate FEMA's efforts to fill requests for personal protective equipment (PPE) from the Strategic National Stockpile, but the materials received to date are woefully inadequate to meet the need. Further, some resource requests appear to be stuck in the queue at the National Response Coordination Center, including:
