**A BILL**

To reauthorize and extend funding for community health centers and the National Health Service Corps.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Community Health In-  
5 vestment, Modernization, and Excellence Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY HEALTH**  
7 **CENTERS AND NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE**  
8 **CORPS.**

9 Section 221 of the Medicare Access and CHIP Reau-  
10 thorization Act of 2015 is amended—

1           (1) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the  
2 following:

3           “(3) ADDITIONAL FUNDING.—In addition to  
4 amounts appropriated under section 10503(b) of the  
5 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, there  
6 are appropriated to the CHC Fund the following:

7           “(A) For purposes of paragraph (1) of  
8 such section—

9                   “(i) for fiscal year 2020,  
10                   \$4,200,000,000;

11                   “(ii) for fiscal year 2021,  
12                   \$4,400,000,000;

13                   “(iii) for fiscal year 2022,  
14                   \$4,600,000,000;

15                   “(iv) for fiscal year 2023,  
16                   \$4,800,000,000; and

17                   “(v) for fiscal year 2024,  
18                   \$5,000,000,000.

19           “(B) For purposes of paragraph (2) of  
20 such section—

21                   “(i) \$325,000,000 for fiscal year  
22                   2020;

23                   “(ii) \$340,000,000 for fiscal year  
24                   2021;

1                   “(iii) \$355,000,000 for fiscal year  
2                   2022;

3                   “(iv) \$370,000,000 for fiscal year  
4                   2023; and

5                   “(v) \$385,000,000 for fiscal year  
6                   2024.”; and

7                   (2) in subsection (c), by striking “and fiscal  
8                   year 2107” and inserting “, fiscal year 2020, fiscal  
9                   year 2021, fiscal year 2022, fiscal year 2023, and  
10                  fiscal year 2024”.
